

## Hire of Equipment

General Terms & Conditions: All hires are subject to the Hire Association of Europe Terms and Conditions, a copy of which is printed on the reverse of our hire contracts.

Deposits: A deposit is required from those customers who do not hold an approved credit account. Deposits can be cash, cheque (when accompanied by a valid cheque guarantee card), or via Mastercard, Visa, Switch or Delta credit/debit cards.

Identification: Two forms of identification are required each and every time you hire. One form must show your current address, e.g. driving licence, utility bill. Identification must belong to the person hiring the equipment. Bus passes, library tickets, business and club membership cards are not acceptable forms of identification. Please note that without a deposit and identification our staff will not be able to hire tools and equipment to you.

Damage Waiver (accidental damage): If equipment is accidentally damaged whilst on hire you risk an unforeseen addition to your bill. For a small indemnity (10% of the hire charge) we will waive any charge for damage repair. This can only be added to the hire contract before hire commences, and only if requested. Damage Waiver is not insurance and does not cover you against loss or theft.

Transport: Delivery and collection can be arranged, charged according to distance. The 4 hour rate (where applicable) does not apply to items delivered.

Collection of Equipment: 24 hours notice is required on all terminations. Items for collection must be readily accessible. Access equipment must be dismantled and stacked at ground level. All items must be returned clean and in sound working order, otherwise charges will be made. Please remember when phoning to arrange to have items collected to obtain a collection number as proof of off-hiring.

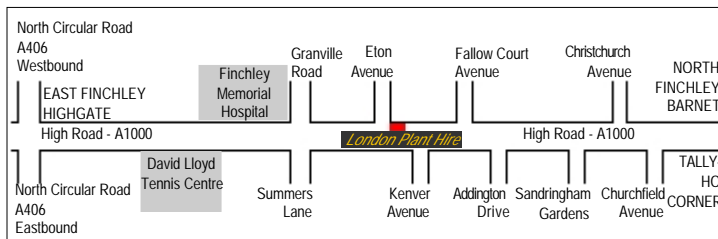
Consumables: All sale items are on a "sale or return" basis. All hire rates quoted are for the hire of the equipment only, sanding sheets, resharpening of blades, steels etc. are chargeable. Any sale items returned must be in an unused and resaleable condition.

Hire Charges: All hire charges are printed on your hire contract. 4 hours (where applicable) = 0-4 hours; 1 day = 4-24 hours; 2 day = 24-48 hours; 3 day = 48-72 hours; week = 72 hours - 7 days; thereafter extra days are charged at 1/7th of the weekly rate. All hire rates are subject to V.A.T. at the current rate. All items are charged on a time out basis and not time used. Sundays and Bank Holidays are chargeable.

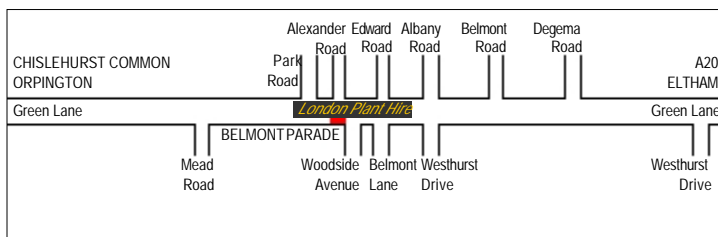
